Boxxer Updates Exploration on Nevada Properties

Calgary, Alberta - Boxxer Gold Corp. (TSXV-"BXX") announces an update of its plans to commence an aggressive exploration program focused on the Boss and Buena Vista gold, copper-gold properties in Nevada.

Buena Vista

The Buena Vista iron oxide-copper-gold (IOCG) property is located approximately 150 kms east of Reno. This property was acquired pursuant to an option agreement announced on February 10, 2006. Commencing the first week of August a program of detailed grid mapping, soil geochemical and infill magnetic surveys is planned to define targets that will be drill tested in late September, subject to final permitting. This exploration will focus on an area of the property where 47 copper and copper \pm gold showings hosted in a large (~4400' x 980') Fe-carbonate alteration zone within the IOCG system were previously identified on the property. Recent channel and chip sampling of eight of the mineral showings within this area also returned significant concentrations of cobalt that ranged from 74 to 6,600 parts per million ("ppm") with an average of 1,100 ppm. Approximately 2000 – 3000 feet of diamond core drilling is planned to initially evaluate the identified targets.

Boss

At the Boss property, located approximately 90 kms southwest of Las Vegas, continued exploration of a number of targets is planned to start later in September. The program includes:

- 1) Continued diamond drilling (~ 5000') of the Yellowhorse porphyry gold zone to test further its down dip and lateral extent (see July press release).
- 2) Drill testing the coincident magnetic anomaly and copper-gold-platinum-palladium-silver mineralization that occurs over a horizontal distance of 2,600 feet between the Boss and Boss 2 mineralized zones. This magnetic anomaly is interpreted to represent a buried porphyry system that could be responsible for the extensive dolomite/marble alteration related to the mineralization in this area. Approximately 2000 feet of drilling is planned.

Mr. Theodore A. DeMatties is an independent geologist consulting to Boxxer and is the Qualified Person who has reviewed and verified the technical information detailed in this release.
